In order to be assured that your bequest will be retained by the parish, please employ the following wording:

WORDING OF BEQUESTS FOR INCLUSION IN A WILL

The appropriate wording to be used when someone wishes to remember the work of God when making their Wills is as follows:

(i) I bequeath to the Trustees of Church Property for the Diocese of Newcastle in the state of New South Wales the sum of to be applied for the benefit of Saint Luke's Wallsend in such manner as the said Trustees may approve.

(ii) I give, devise and bequeath all that piece or parcel of land being to the Trustees of Church Property for the Diocese of Newcastle in the state of New South Wales for the general purpose of Saint Luke's Wallsend.

(iii) I bequeath to the Trustees of Church Property for the Diocese of Newcastle in the state of New South Wales the sum of in trust to apply the income arising from the investment of such sum for the benefit of Saint Luke's Wallsend.
